The volume of real estate documents recorded in Orange County surged in 2012,

marking the highest amount since 2006, confirming renewed activity in the local

housing market as the economy slowly recovers. Document recordings for 2012 hit 817,537, rising 18% over the 690,613 documents recorded in 2011. The next highest volume of documents was recorded in 2006, when 878,605 transactions were processed. "Document recordings last year reflected growing confidence in the housing market and that's a hopeful trend," said Assistant Clerk-Recorder Renee Ramirez.
