FIRST TITLE INDUSTRY OPEN HOUSE A SUCCESS

Representatives from the title industry gathered June 27 at the Orange County Hall of Administration for an



open house hosted by Orange County Clerk-Recorder Hugh Nguyen. Topics covered at the session included an Q and A on the county's multicounty Electronic Recording Delivery System (SECURE), ways the department provides training for title industry customers, the Top 10 reasons that documents are rejected for being recorded and suggestions for how department staff can help ease the process of both electronic and paper document recording. Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collector Shari Freidenrich offered a brief overview of her office while Orange County Supervisor John Moorlach helped welcome visitors. 




