Orange County has electronically recorded its 6th millionth property document since 1997, the year the

county launched a groundbreaking electronic recording system now available to counties statewide. The landmark document, a grant deed submitted by Fidelity National Title, was electronically recorded at 8:39 a.m. on Feb. 2. Orange County is a recognized national leader in electronic recording. Each year, nearly twothirds of all property documents recorded locally are transmitted electronically by 150 authorized userswithout a single known security breach.






